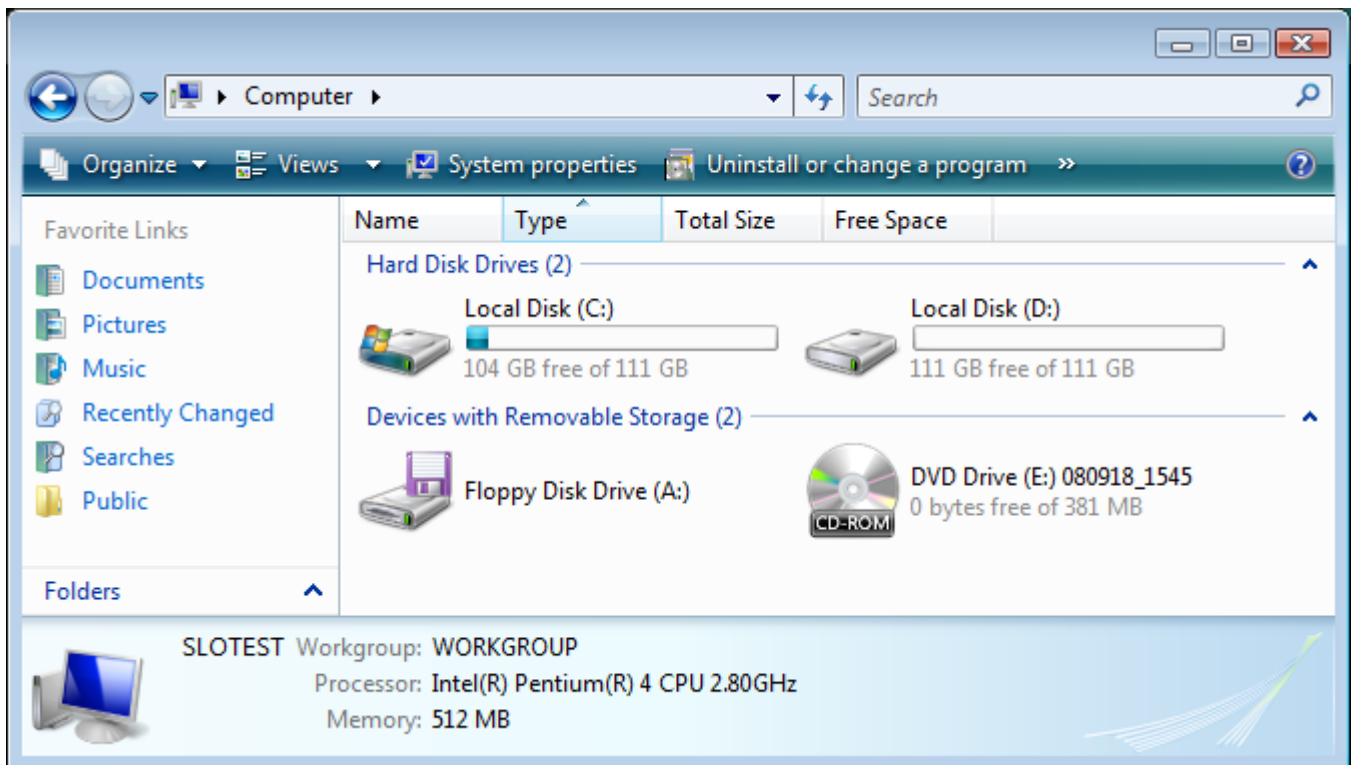


Installing Symantec Antivirus (Endpoint Protection 11.0) on Windows Vista

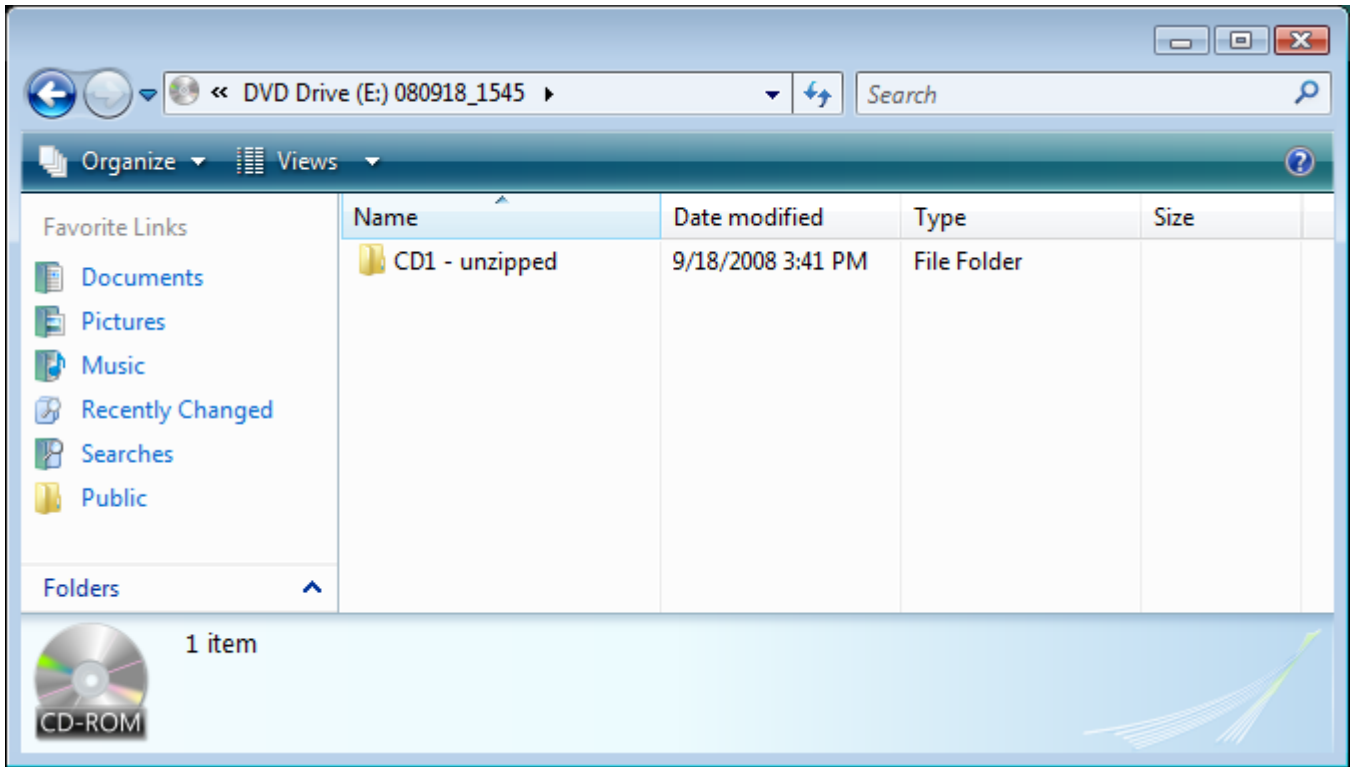
On some versions of Windows Vista, the program to install Symantec Antivirus may not automatically run. Users can use the following instructions to manually start the installation program.

NOTE: Before installing Symantec Antivirus (Endpoint Protection 11.0), please be sure to *uninstall* any current versions of Symantec or other antivirus programs from your computer.

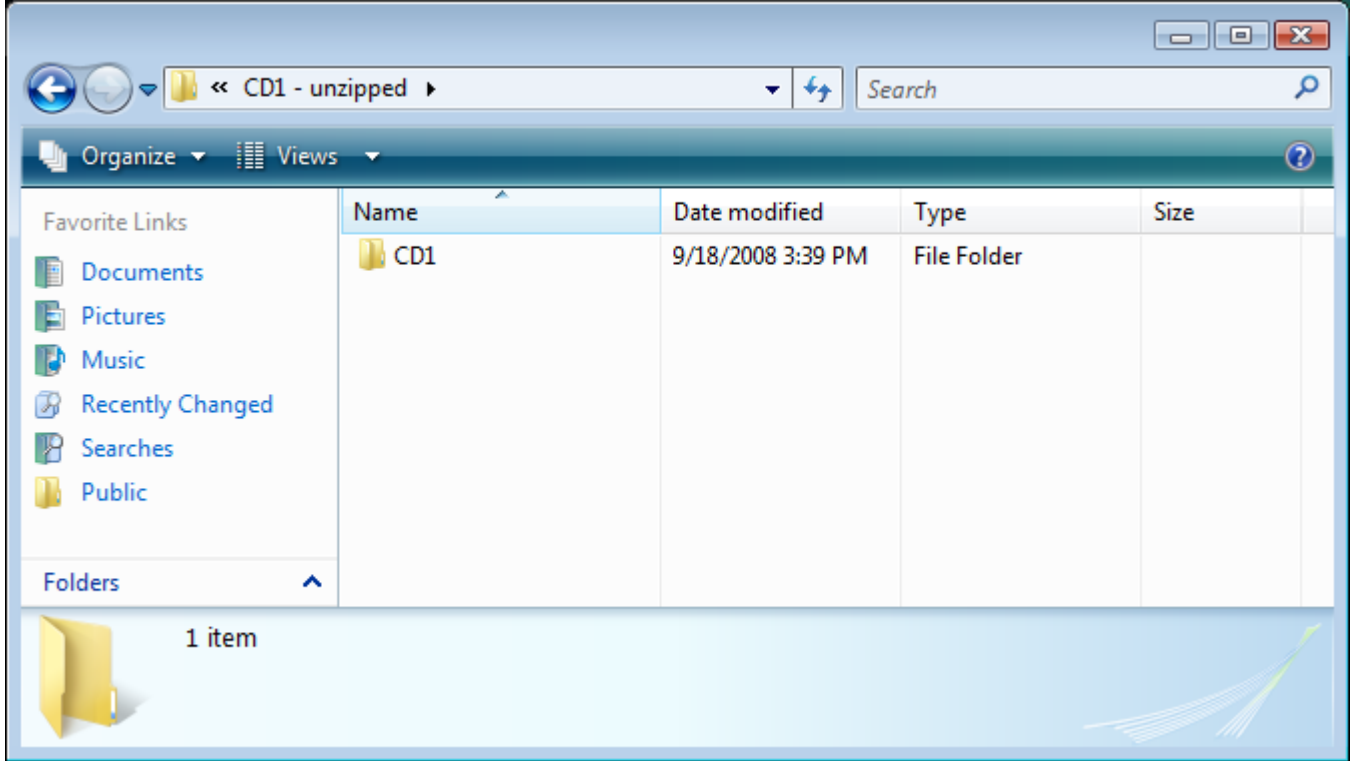
1. Close all open applications.
2. Open the Start Menu and select the "Computer" option.



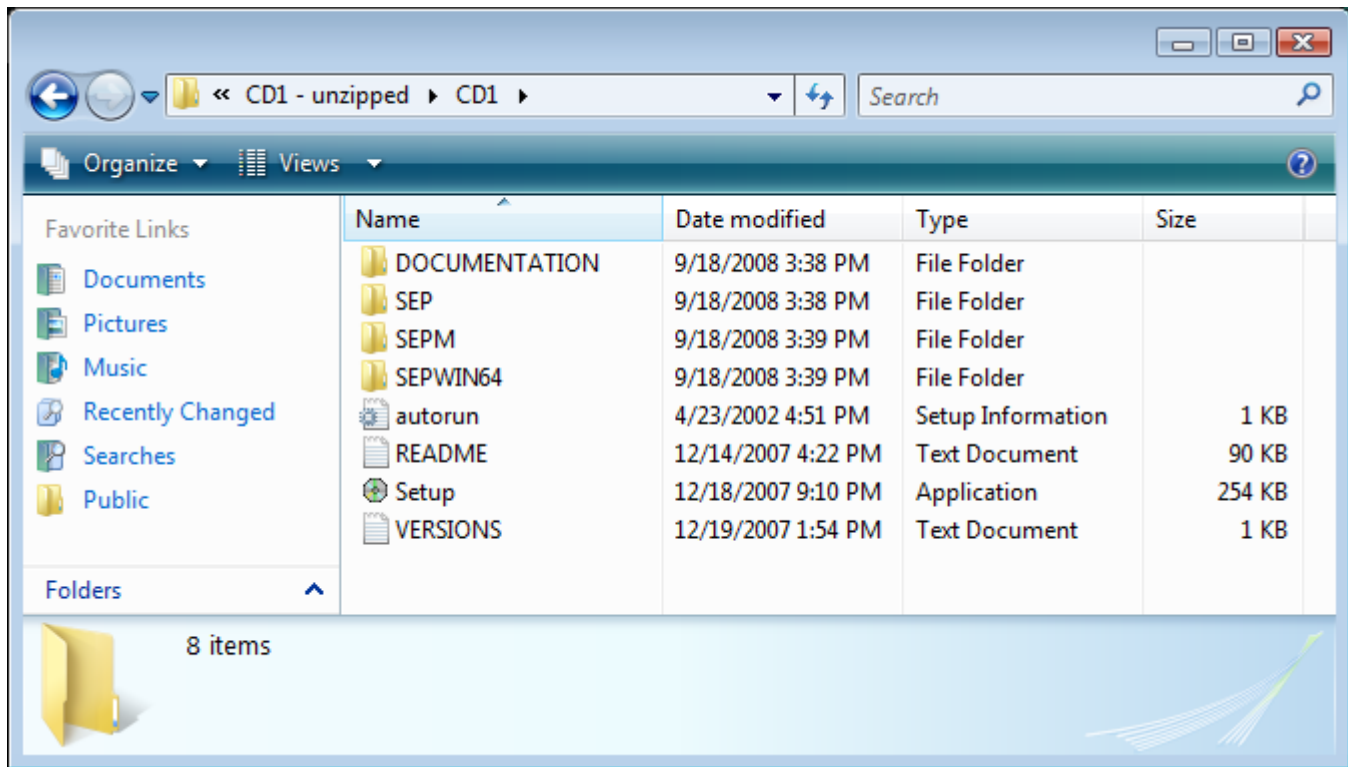
3. Double-click on the option for the DVD or CD Drive to access the Symantec Antivirus (Endpoint Protection 11.0) CD.



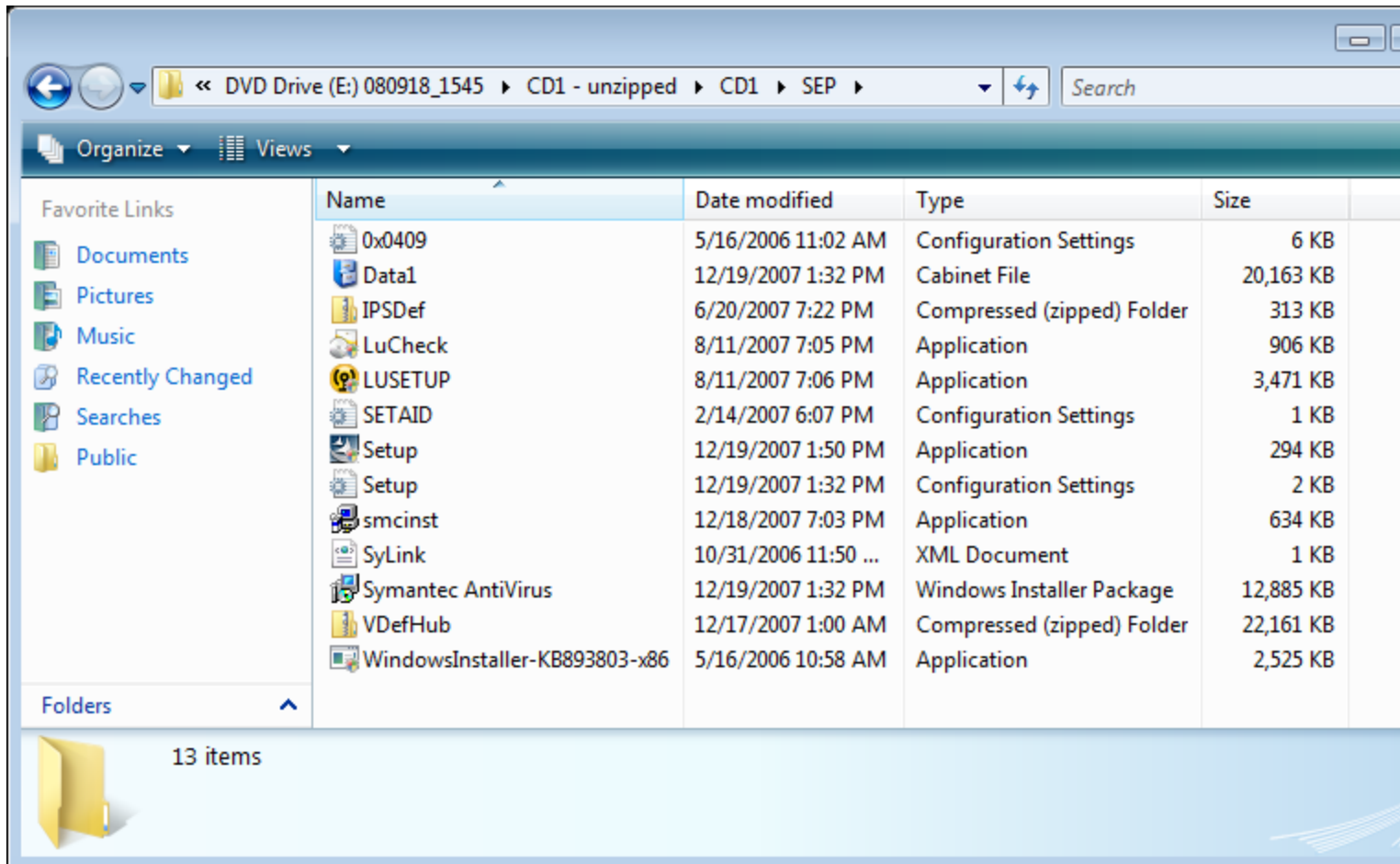
4. Double-click on the CD-1 Unzipped folder



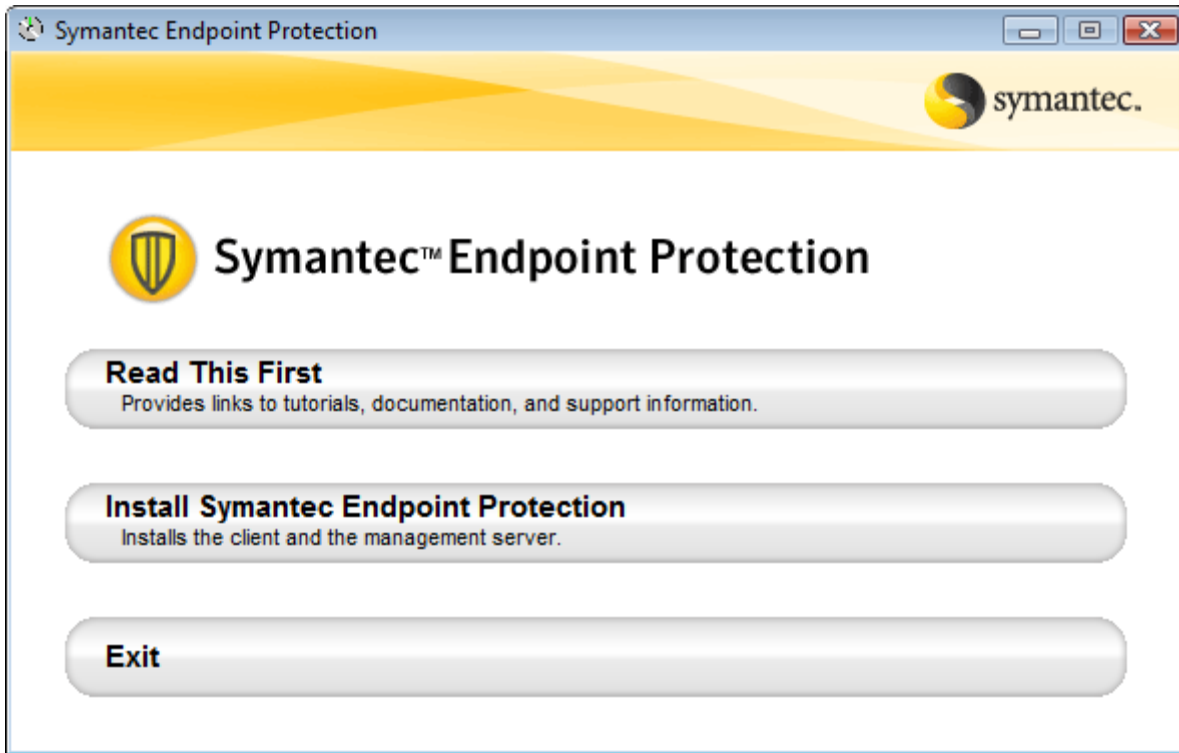
5. Double-click on the CD1 folder



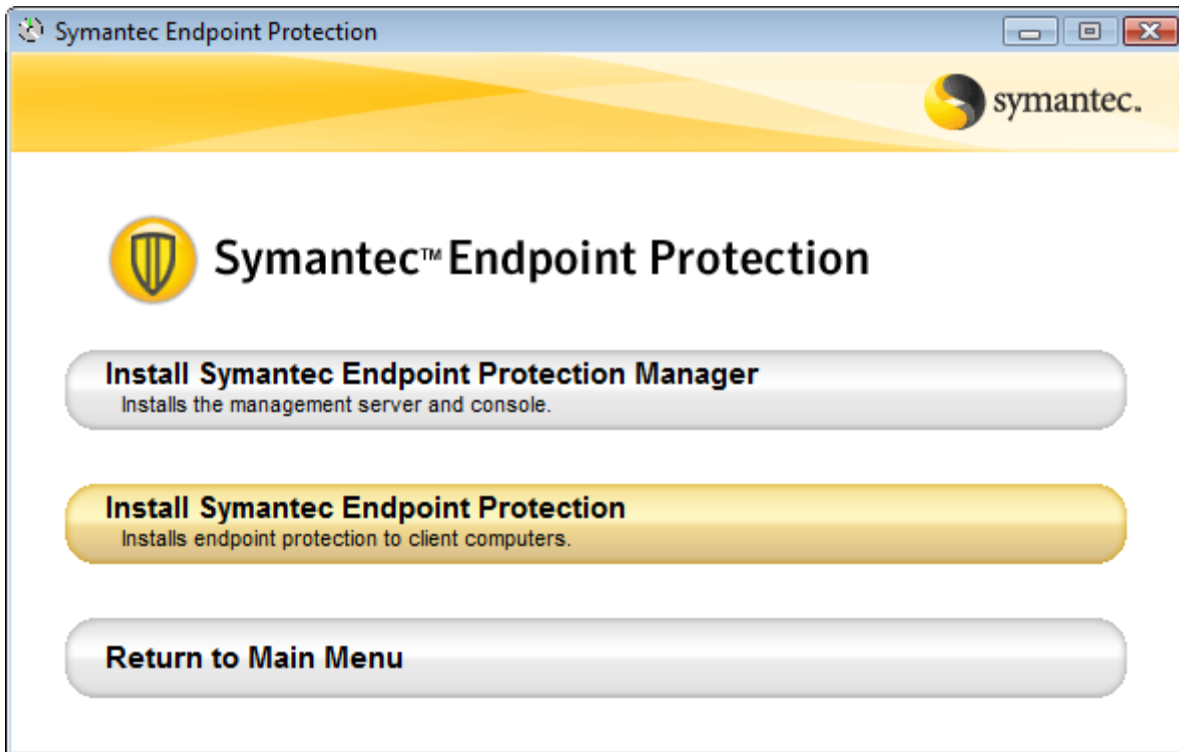
6. Double-click on the SEP folder



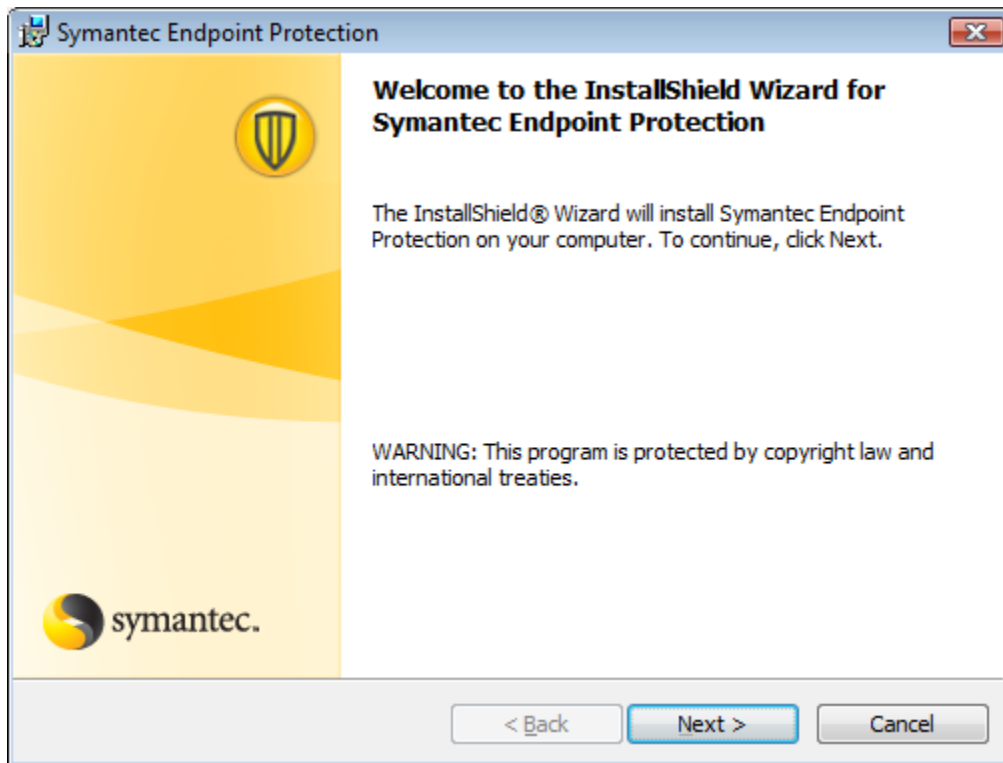
7. Double-click on the Setup icon (setup.exe, file type Application)



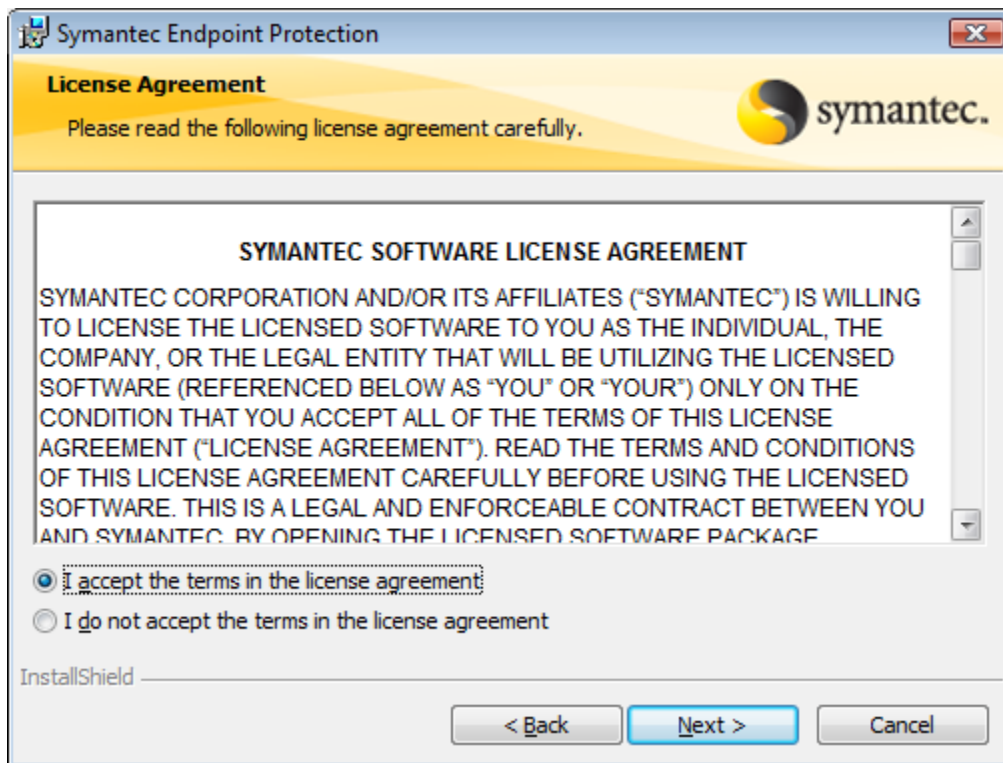
8. Click on Install Symantec Endpoint Protection



9. Click on Install Symantec Endpoint Protection



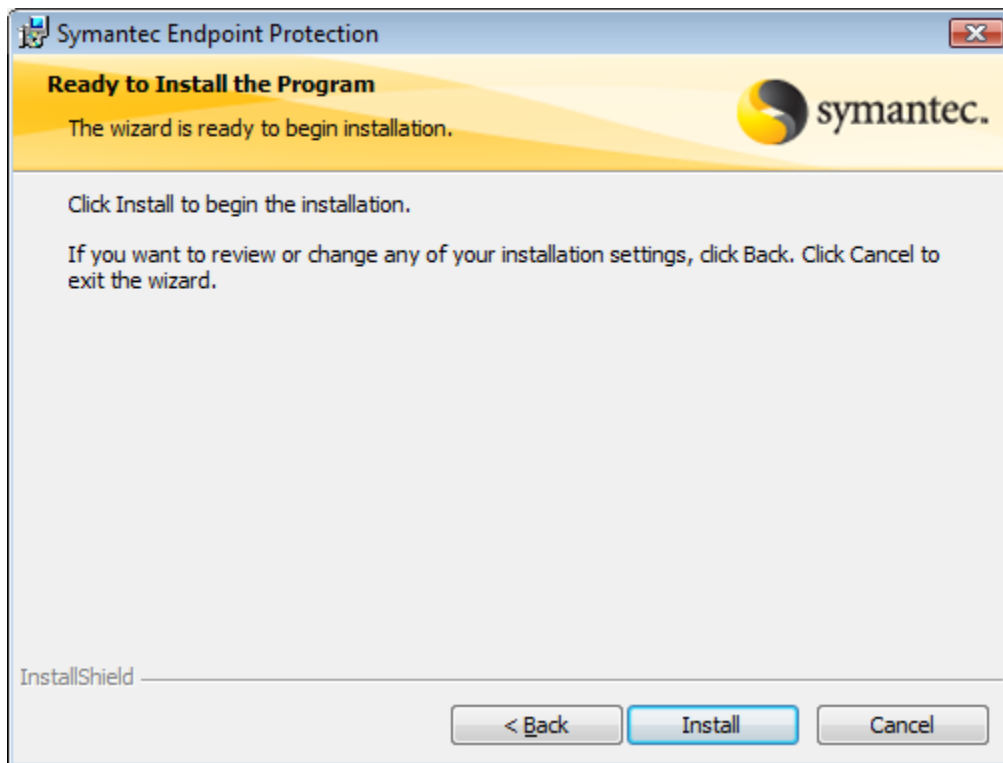
10. Click on Next



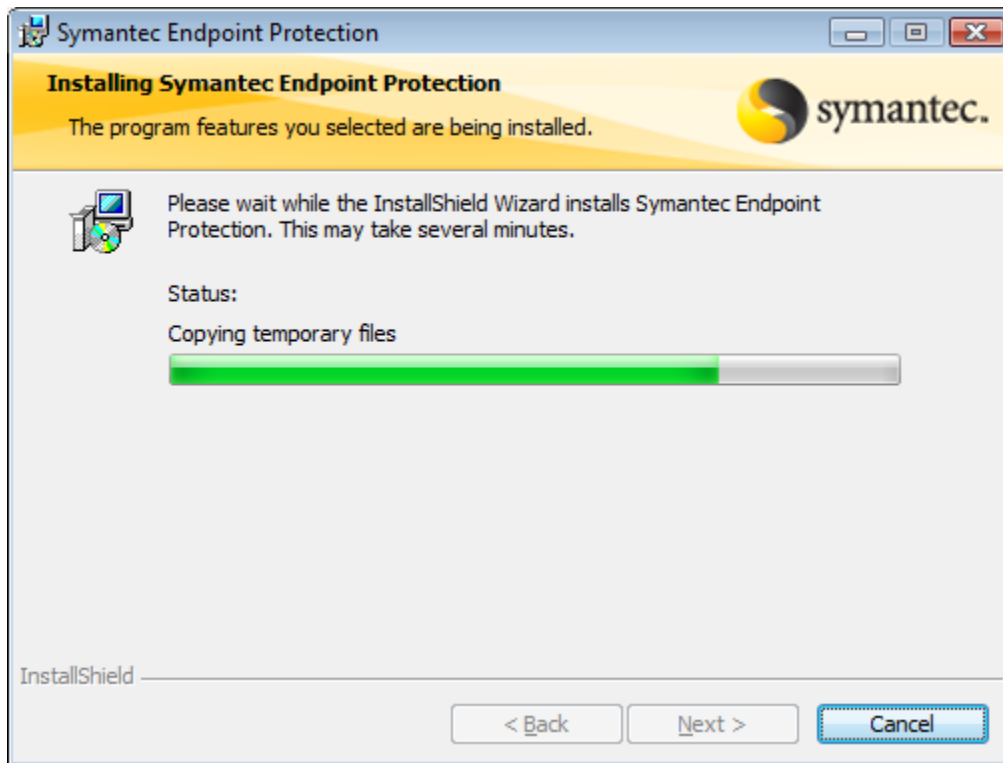
11. Read and Accept the License Agreement. Click on Next.



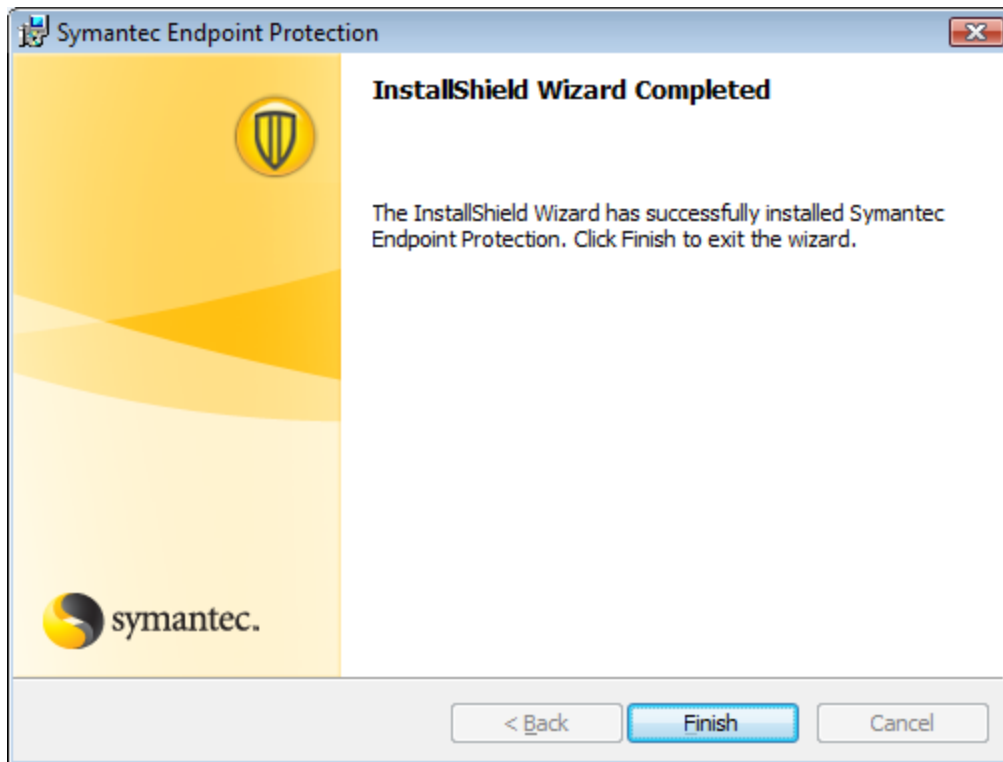
12. Select Typical and click on Next



13. Click on Next



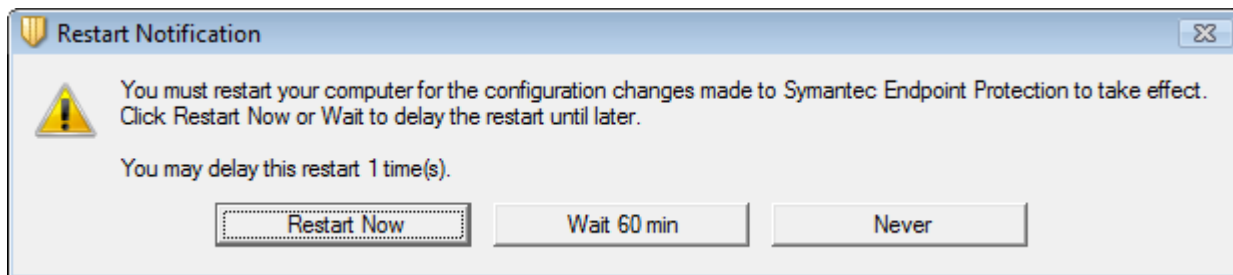
14. The install could take several minutes. Click on Next.

16. The LiveUpdate process will get the latest virus definitions.
