

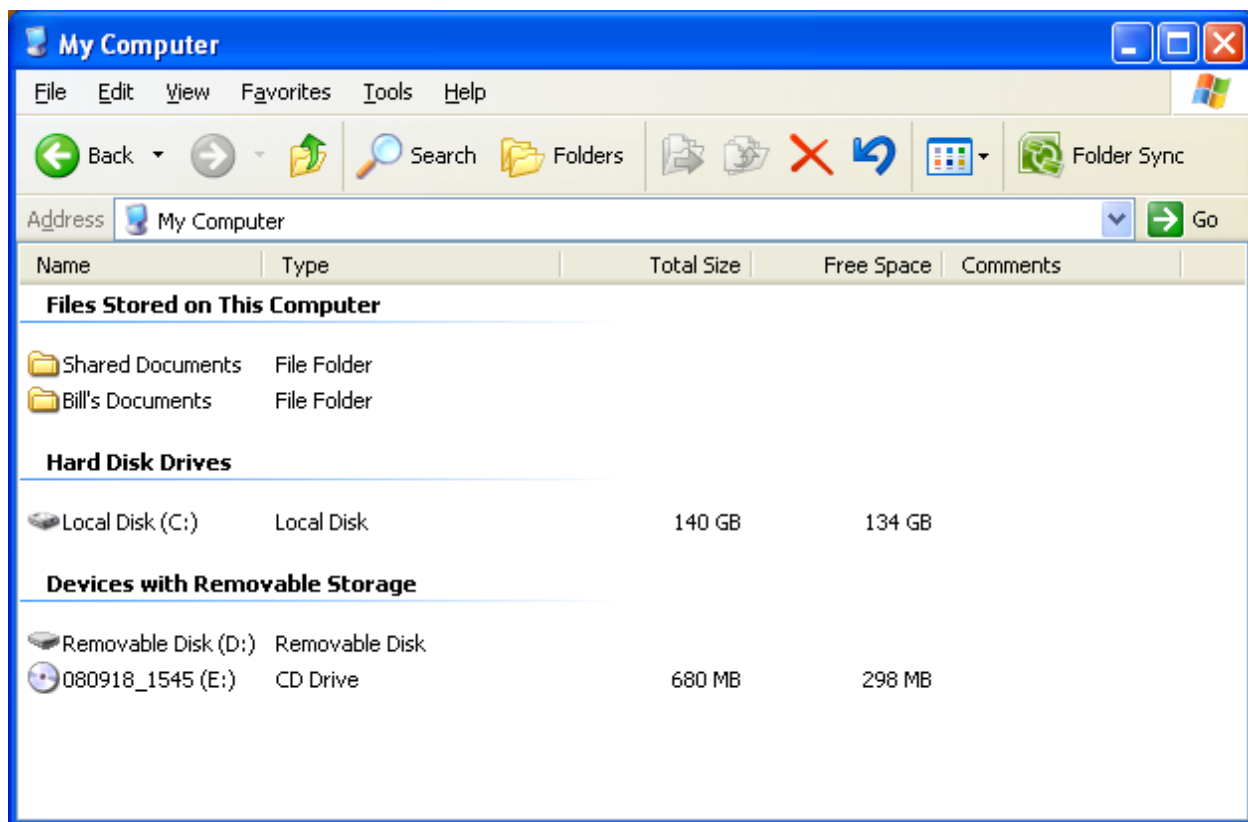

## ***Installing Symantec Antivirus (Endpoint Protection 11.0) on Windows XP***

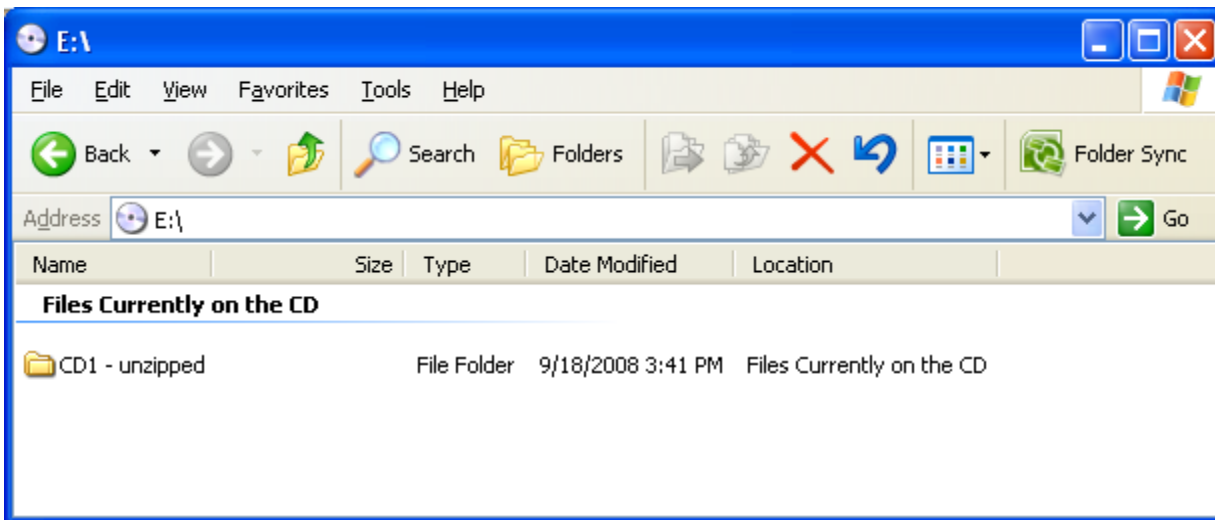
On some versions of Windows Vista, the program to install Symantec Antivirus may not automatically run. Users can use the following instructions to manually start the installation program.

**NOTE:** Before installing Symantec Antivirus (Endpoint Protection 11.0), please be sure to *uninstall* any current versions of Symantec or other antivirus programs from your computer.

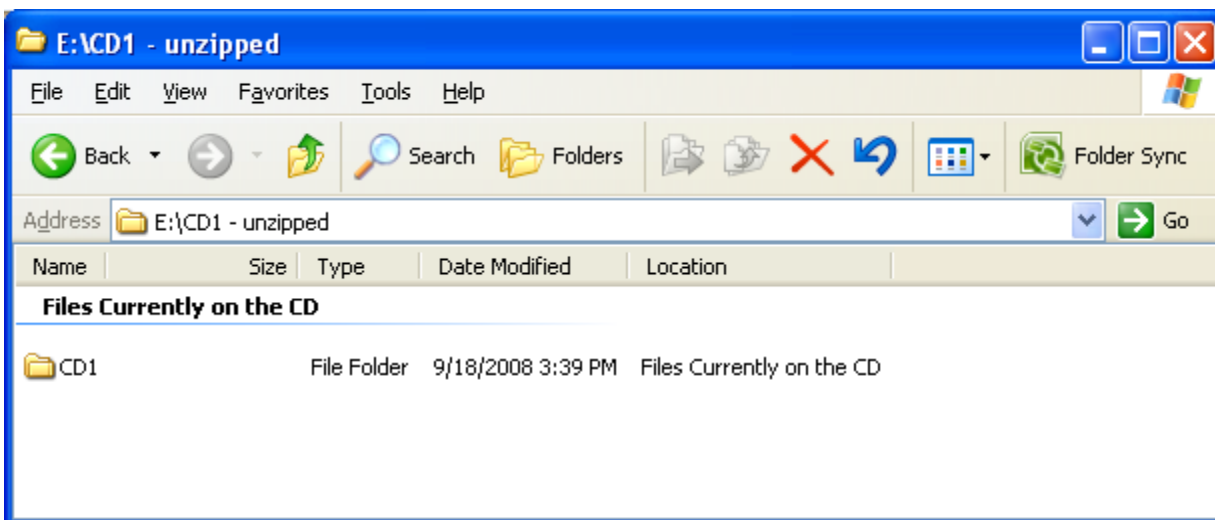
1. Close all open applications.
2. Open the Start Menu and select the “Computer” option.



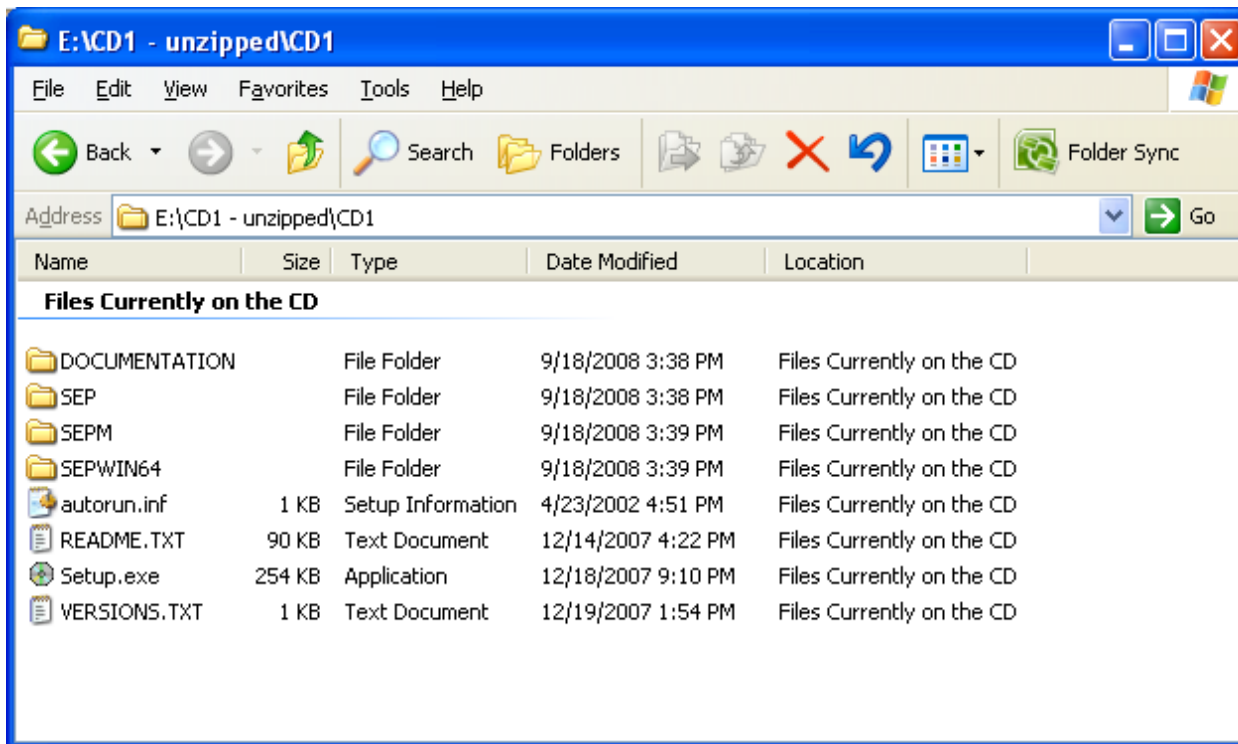
3. Double-click on the option for the DVD or CD Drive to access the Symantec Antivirus (Endpoint Protection 11.0) CD.



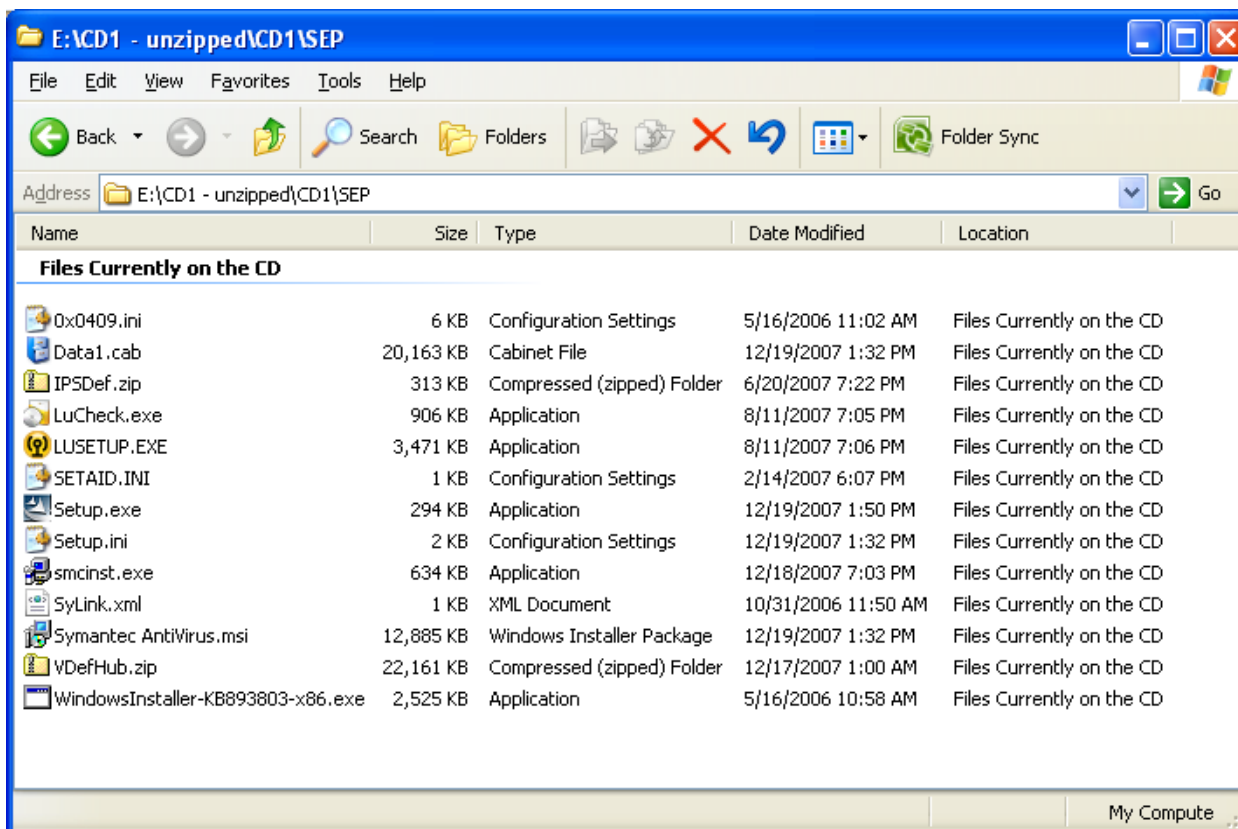
4. Double-click on the CD-1 Unzipped folder



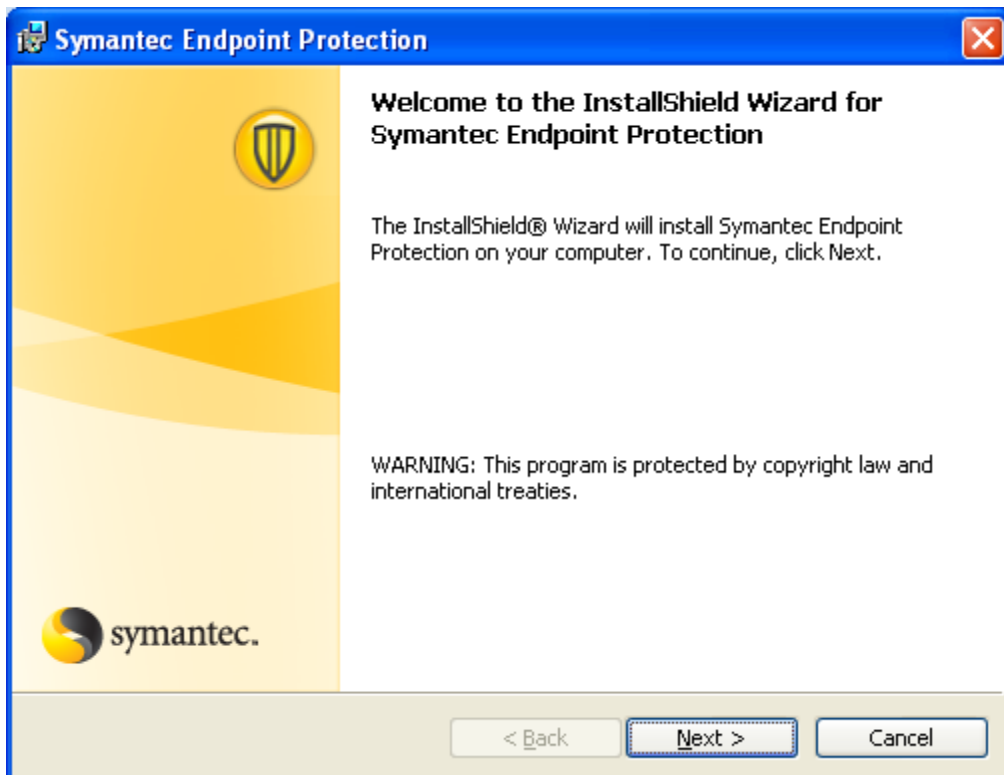
5. Double-click on the CD1 folder



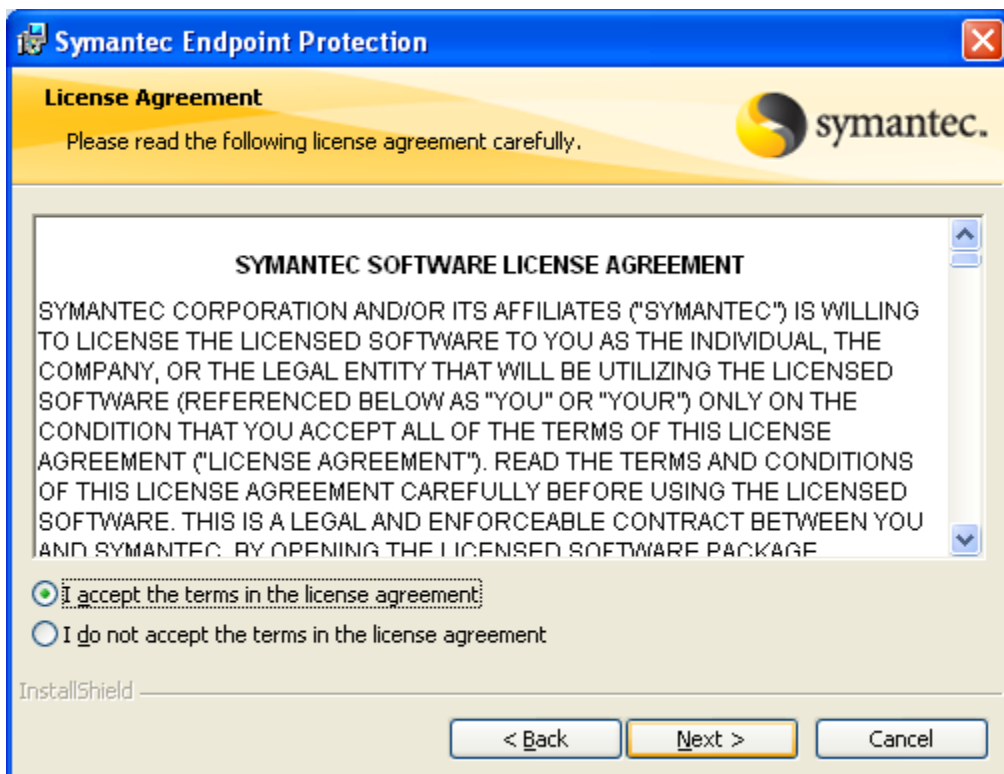
6. Double-click on the SEP folder



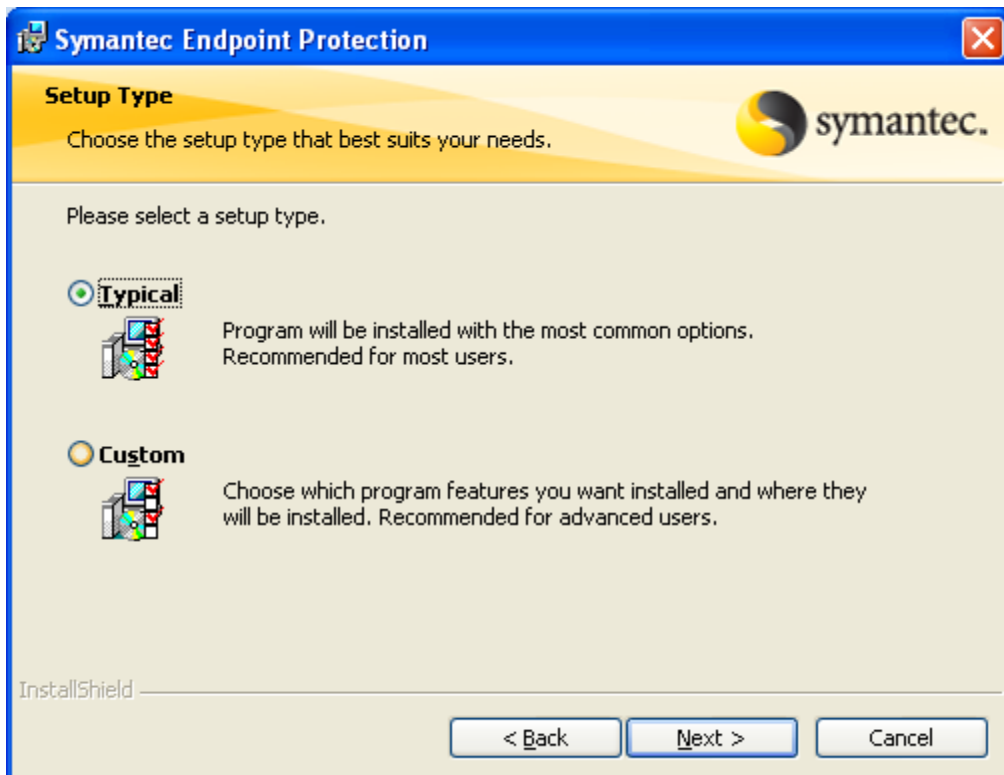
7. Double-click on the Setup icon (setup.exe, file type Application)



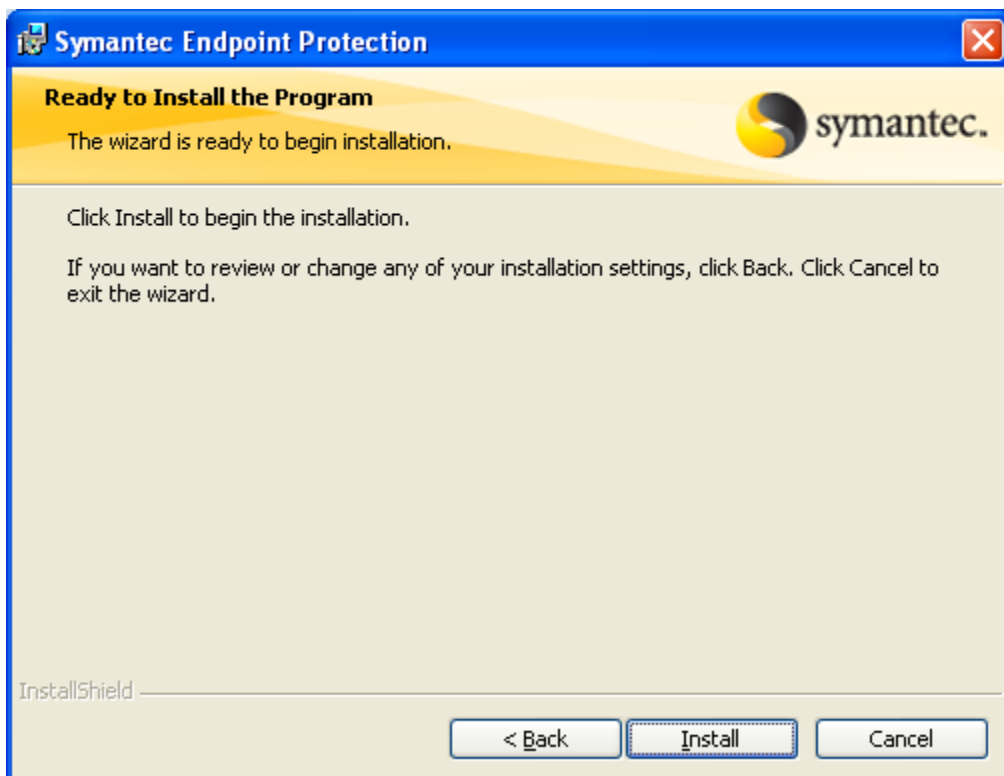
8. Click on Next



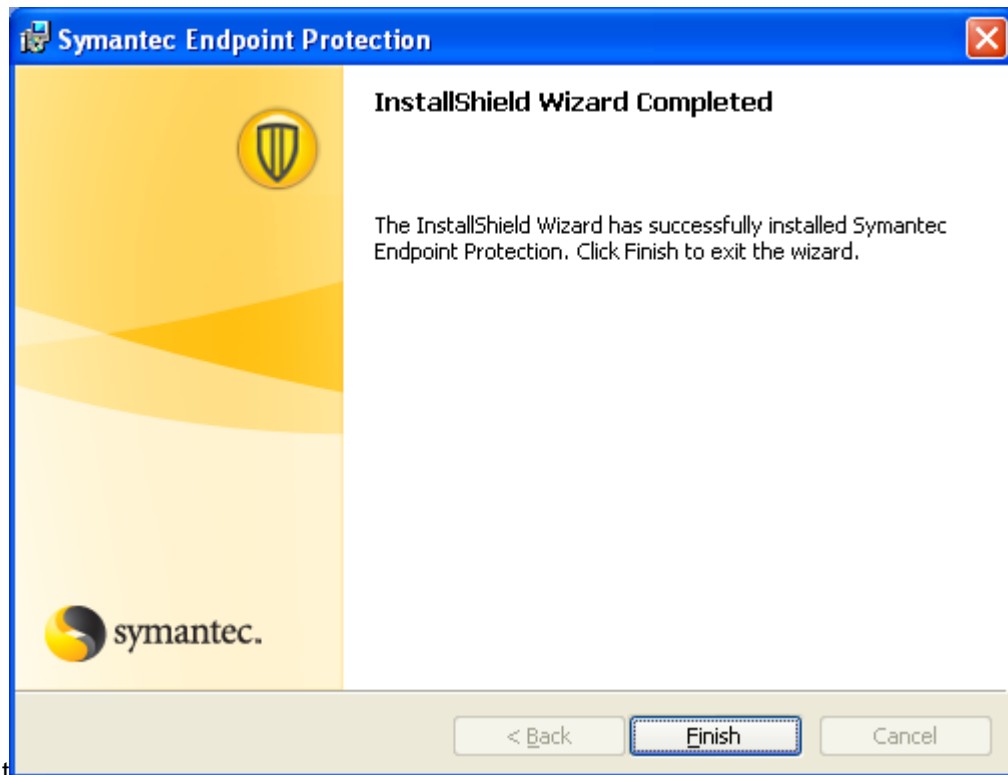
9. Read and accept the License Agreement



10. Select Typical, then click on Next



11. Click on Next



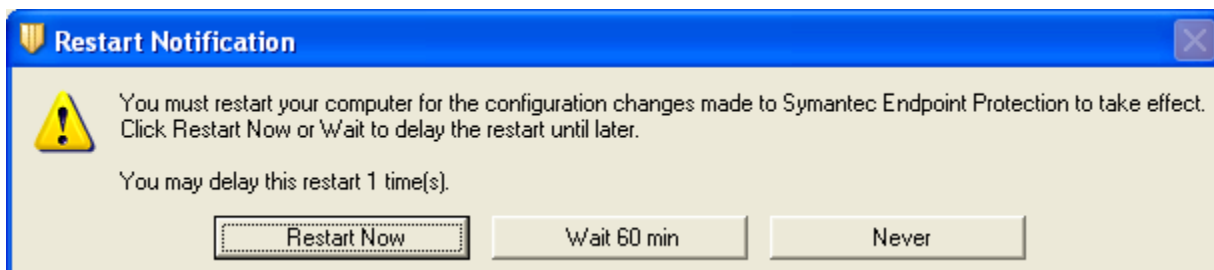
12. The install could take several minutes. Click on Finish



13. The LiveUpdate process will get the latest virus definitions.



14. Click on Close when LiveUpdate session is complete



15. Click on Restart Now
