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Benefits of Encryption

Encryption techniques are used to prevent any unauthorized individuals from reading or altering data stored or transmitted across our campus wide network. UMB faculty, staff and students share sensitive data across our network. To protect our data and eliminate the risk of access by unauthorized parties, public key encryption and/or secure key exchange are being utilized in Open WebMail.

ENCRYPTION SETTINGS

Open WebMail has already been set for encryption. If you are using one of the other clients (Eudora, Netscape, Outlook or Outlook Express) to access your UMnet mail, you need to configure the client incoming server settings to SSL (Secure Socket Layer).
