How to Apply for Federal Aid?	Types of Financial Aid	General Eligibility
Students should visit studentaid.gov to fill out a valid FAFSA before each academic year. Students who are U.S. Citizens or eligible non-U.S. citizens must have a valid FAFSA on file with the university to be reviewed for eligibility. Students must submit a valid FAFSA for the appropriate academic year with our Federal School Code 002104.	There is a plethora of resources available to assist students in funding their academic career including but not limited to: • Federal Loans • Federal Grants • Federal Work-Study • Institutional Scholarships • School Specific Scholarships • State Scholarships • Private Loans	You must demonstrate financial need (for some programs); be a U.S. citizen or an eligible noncitizen; have a valid Social Security number (with the exception of students from the Republic of the Marshall Islands, Federated States of Micronesia, or the Republic of Palau) Students must be properly enrolled in at least 6 credits, which is half time status.
