A rejected item is no longer modifiable but can be restored if needed.







Number of Items Sent Back (Declined)





The Board of Regents recognizes the distinct and complementary roles that the Regents, the Chancellor, the Presidents, other administrators, the faculty, the staff, and students have in governing the USM institutions.



Description: USM's & UMB's policy on shared governance fully discloses the legally onstituted governance structure. This policy list the fundamental principles for shared governance and the Board of Regents authority and responsibility to ensure these principles apply to all levels of the institution. 
