Program Overview

PALLA is proud to sponsor one full-time Maryland PA faculty member to attend the prestigious Harvard Macy Institute's Virtual Program on Assessment and Evaluation: Systems Thinking in Health Professions Education. This immersive 5-day virtual course (April 6–10, 2026) equips educators with innovative strategies in assessment, evaluation, and curriculum design through a systems thinking lens. The selected Leader-in-Residence will receive full sponsorship and mentorship to implement a meaningful quality improvement initiative within their institution.

Application Instructions

Step 1: Review Program Details

Ensure the program aligns with your professional goals and institutional capacity.

Step 2: Secure Institutional Support

Discuss the opportunity with your program leadership. A signed letter of institutional support is required (template provided) to initiate the application process. Submit your letter of institutional support (see below) to Jamie King at jking001@umaryland.edu and a full PALLA application link will provided.

Step 3: Apply to the Harvard Macy Program

Submit your application by December 31, 2025 via the Harvard Macy website:

- Project proposal including:
 - Title and description
 - Context and anticipated impact
 - Outcomes and evaluation plan

Note: Notification of acceptance from Harvard within 8 weeks from of application.



You may apply to PALLA while awaiting Harvard Macy acceptance. Only one applicant will be selected for sponsorship. *Acceptance to Harvard Macy does not guarantee PALLA sponsorship*.

Step 4: Apply to the PALLA Leader-in-Residence Program

Submit your application to PALLA, including:

- The same project proposal submitted to Harvard Macy
- A personal statement (max 500 words)
- A signed letter of institutional support (attached)

Leader-in-Residence Activities:

Presentation at PALLA Research Hour: October, 2026 (at MdAPA conference)

OR

Presentation at Symposium: March or April 2027

- ✓ Obtain a signed letter of institutional support (template provided)

- √ Apply to the Harvard Macy Program by December 31, 2025
- ✓ Apply to the PALLA Leader-in-Residence Program including all required materials.

Institutional Commitments

- **Protected Time**: Up to 2 hours per week for project implementation, monthly coaching sessions, and program deliverables, including:
 - Two presentations
 - One project write-up/white paper
 - Monthly coaching sessions with PALLA mentor who holds implementation science and quality improvement specialization (optional biweekly sessions)
- Attendance Support: Full release time for the virtual 5-day Harvard Macy Institute course (in addition, 1 pre- and 1 post-course session).
- Project Resources: Access to institutional resources necessary for successful project execution, as outlined in project proposal.
- **Project Sponsorship**: A designated sponsor from our institution will meet biweekly to monthly to support project implementation.
