

UMB Auth Guest Wireless Access (Limited Requests)

UMB Auth Guest Wireless Access is for anyone that has been sponsored by a UMB employee and who require up to 30 days of continuous access. You will be provided with username and password from your sponsor.

Getting started please follow the steps below.

Connecting:

From any device go to your wireless settings (Windows, Mac, iPhone/iPad, and Android):


Windows 10:

Select the Network  or  icon in the notification area.


Mac:

Click the Wi-Fi icon ( or ) in the menu bar.

iPhone/iPad:

From your Home screen, go to  **Settings > Wi-Fi**

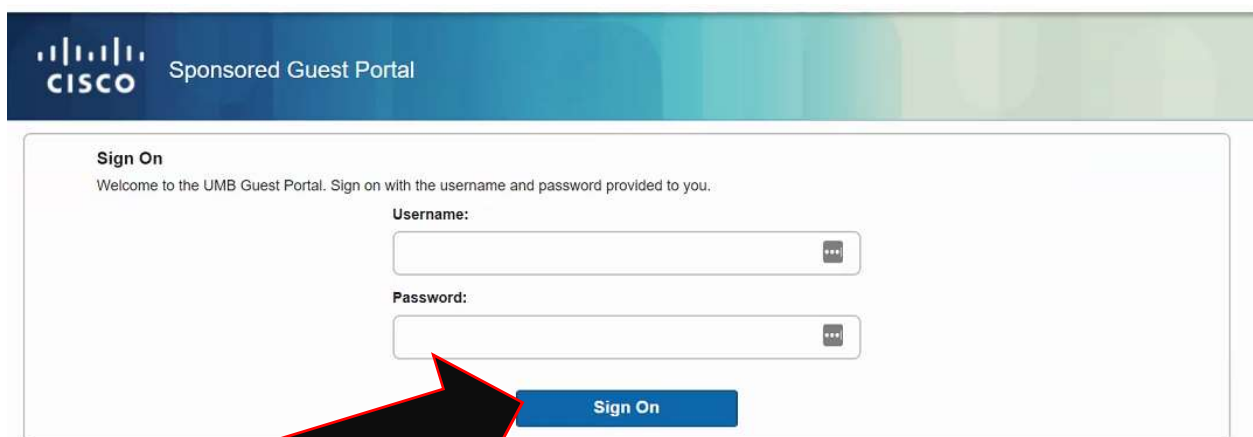
Android:

Swipe down to access your **Quick Settings** and tap on  to turn on your **Wi-Fi** settings

How to Sponsor:
