How can the youth gain access to information about career internships, job etiquette, resumes, and skills to work on different careers?

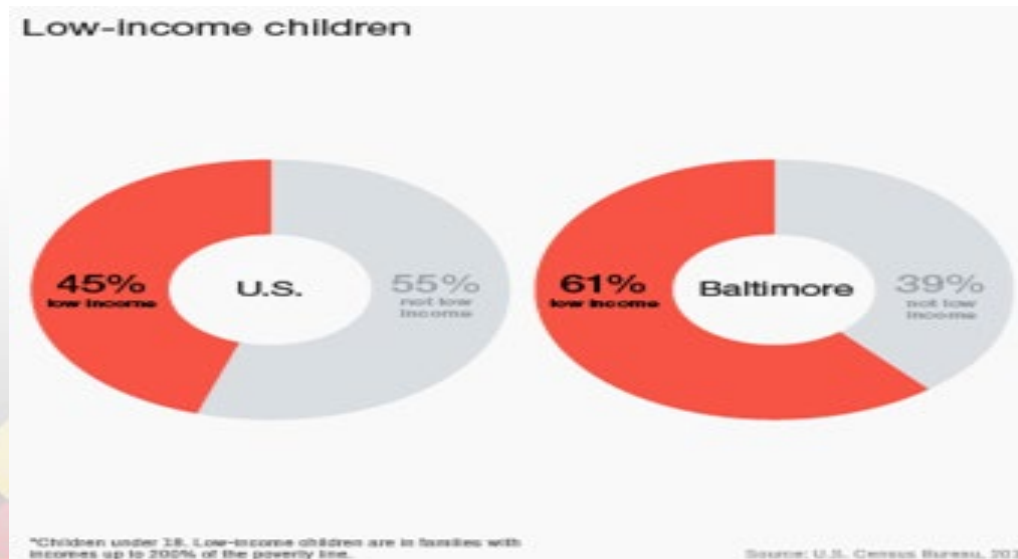
# Our Impact
