Safe Ride	Request through Mobile UMB app
Student Counseling Center	410-328-8404
Maintenance Service Center	410-706-7570 (on campus: 6-7570) <i>Report problems with buildings/utilities</i>
Environmental Health and Safety (EHS)	410-706-7055 (on campus: 6-7055) <i>Non-life-threatening safety/health hazards</i>
Center for Information Technology Services (CITS)	410-706-4357 (on campus: 6-4357) <i>IT assistance; report cybersecurity incidents</i>

What to Do

Active Assailant	Run, hide, fight; Avoid, deny, defend
Fire/Smoke	Activate the fire alarm, evacuate, call 911
Tornado	Move to an interior room, basement, or lowest level
Earthquake	Drop, cover, hold on; Stay inside unless unsafe
