JOSEPH U. DORSCH SR., BSP '39, PHARMACY MUSEUM

Discover rare bottles, vintage prescriptions, and historic artifacts that trace the legacy of pharmacy and the University of Maryland School of Pharmacy. Highlights include diplomas of Alpheus Sharp (1842) and Louis Dohme (1857), who co-founded the company Merck Sharp & Dohme.



HISTORICAL COLLECTIONS AT THE HSHSL

Explore the archives that tell UMB's story! This repository houses rare books and records from the Schools of Dentistry, Graduate Studies, Nursing, Medicine, Pharmacy, and Social Work. Attendees can interact with unique artifacts that trace UMB's 19th-century origins.
