2022-2023 Estimated Cost of Attendance and Financial Aid

Carey School of Law-LLM Program

Applicants needing federal and institutional financial assistance to help with the cost of attending a school or program at UMB must complete the **Free Application for Federal Aid (FAFSA)**. Please note:

- Each year, the FAFSA is available on October 1st. USFA strongly encourages completing the FAFSA at studentaid.gov no later than March 1st for priority consideration. UMB School Code: **002104**
- The 2022-2023 FAFSA covers the 2022-2023 Academic Year (Summer 2022, Fall 2022 and Spring 2023).
- Students must complete a FAFSA for every academic year they wish to receive assistance.

Estimated Cost of Attendance

The Cost of Attendance (COA) is the maximum amount of financial assistance available to a student in one academic year. The COA is based on residency and the flat-rate tuition charges for students enrolled in 12-14 credits per semester.
