Social Work PhD Program

Applicants needing federal and institutional financial assistance to help with the cost of attending a school or program at UMB must complete the **Free Application for Federal Aid** (FAFSA). Please note:

- ➤ Each year, the FAFSA is available on October 1st. USFA strongly encourages completing the FAFSA at https://studentaid.gov no later than March 1st for priority consideration.
- ➤ The 2022-2023 FAFSA covers the 2022-2023 Academic Year (Summer 2022, Fall 2022, and Spring 2023)
- > Students must complete a FAFSA for every academic year they wish to receive assistance

Estimated Cost of Attendance

The Cost of Attendance (COA) is the maximum amount of financial assistance available to a student in one academic year. The COA is determined using each student's enrollment and residency classification (Resident or Non-Resident). Tuition is based upon enrollment of twelve (12) credits.
