Job description: Dental provider and oral health educator

This position is for the Periodontics resident with who provides care to the underserved residents of Baltimore in the dental clinics at the University of Maryland School of Dentistry. There are 10 total positions available. The position starts July 1, 2025 though the mid May 2026. The position entails informing underserved residents about preventive dental care and providing oral health education. This may include composing letters to submit to other health providers to aid the patient's overall health management and to provide communication necessary to submit for coverage of the necessary dental care.

This position is considered a part-time position and only occurs during regular dental clinic hours. The qualifications for this position are a BDS, DDS, or DMD degree and enrolled as a student in Advanced Dental Education Program in Periodontics (Post-graduate Periodontics).
