5. Read the form overview carefully

Form Overview

I-765, Application For Employment Authorization

Certain foreign nationals who are in the United States may file Form 1-765, Application for Employment Authorization, to request employment authorization and an Employment Authorization Document (EAD). Other foreign nationals whose immigration status authorizes them to work in the United States without restrictions may also use Form 1-765 to apply for an EAD that shows such authorization.

Foreign nationals may also apply for a Social Security number and card on Form I-765.

If you are a lawful permanent resident, a conditional permanent resident, or a nonimmigrant only authorized for employment with a specific employer under 8 CFR 274a.12(b), do not use Form I-765.

Before You Start Your Application

Eligibility

Only certain F-1 students seeking optional practical training (OPT) may file Form I-765 online. This includes:

- · Pre-completion OPT (c)(3)(A) eligibility category;
- · Post-completion OPT (c)(3)(B) eligibility category; or
- a 24-month extension for STEM students (students holding a degree in science technology, engineering, or mathematics) - (c)(3)(C) eligibility category.

- Answer as many questions as you can

Who Can Submit Form I-765 Online?

Initial release of online I-765 is limited to students in these categories:

- (c)(3)(A) Student Pre-Completion OPT
- (c)(3)(B) Student Post-Completion OPT
- (c)(3)(C) STEM Extension



All other categories **must submit a paper** form I-765

IMPORTANT: Eligibility category information

Category	Description	What it means
(c) (3) (A)	Pre-completion OPT	Employment authorization for work you do before you complete your program of study. **Few UMB students apply for this category of work authorization, please check with OIS if you are thinking about selecting this category.
(c) (3) (B)	Post-completion OPT	Employment authorization for work that you will start after you complete your program of study. ** The earliest you can apply is 90 days before your complete your program.
(c) (3) (C)	STEM Extension	Students who studied in certain Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math fields may be eligible. <u>See OIS website for details</u> . **You can only apply if you are currently in an authorized period of Post- completion OPT

13. Prepare documents to upload

Filling Out the Form—Evidence

All F-1 I-765 applicants must provide:

- Passport-style photograph
- I-94 card, travel document, or electronic I-94
- Most recent EAD, if you have one, or government-issued photo ID
- Proof of enrollment at SEVP-certified school

13. Review evidence for STEM Extension

Evidence Specific to Student Category

U.S. Citizenshi and Immigrat Services

24-month STEM OPT (c)(3)(C)

- Evidence of degree that is basis for STEM OPT and is listed on STEM Designated Degree Program List
- Form I-20, endorsed by DSO within 60 days before filing I-765
- If you seek STEM OPT extension based on previously earned STEM degree, provide evidence that your school is currently accredited by U.S. Department of Education and certified by SEVP



14. Review the pre- and post- completion evidence

Evidence Specific to Student Category

Pre-completion OPT (c)(3)(A)

- Proof of enrollment at SEVP-certified school
- All prior SEVIS numbers and proof of previously authorized CPT / OPT and corresponding academic level—include under Additional Information
- Form I-20, Certificate of Eligibility for Nonimmigrant Student Status, endorsed by DSO before filing I-765

Post-completion OPT (c)(3)(B)

- All prior SEVIS numbers and proof of previously authorized CPT / OPT and corresponding academic level—include under Additional Information
- DSO must enter OPT recommendation in SEVIS within 30 days before you submit I-765, if not, we will deny OPT request

The only characters allowed in document file name are:

- English letters
- Numbers
- Spaces
- Periods .
- Hyphens -
- Underscores
- Parentheses ()

***Do NOT use special characters

Filling Out the Form—Formats

- · Photos: JPG, JPEG, or PNG
- Documents: JPG, JPEG, PDF, TIF or TIFF
- Foreign language documents must have English translation
- Maximum size: 6 MB per file



Required Documents to Upload – All Applicants

- Passport-sized photo
- Passport biographical page
- I-94 PDF from your <u>most recent</u> entry to the United States: <u>https://i94.cbp.dhs.gov/I94/#/recent-search</u>
- Your I-20 with the OPT recommendation for this specific request on page 2
 - Post-completion OPT I-20 cannot be more than 30 days old on the day you submit your OPT application to USCIS
 - STEM Extension I-20 cannot be more than 60 days old on the day you submit your OPT application to USCIS

Other Documents to Upload – if applicable

- Previously issued I-20(s) with CPT or OPT notations on page 2
- Previously issued EAD card(s) (front and back)
- Copy of diploma and transcript (STEM Extensions)
- Proof of full-time enrollment for at least one academic year, i.e. transcript (pre-completion OPT)
