

Recapturing Days Spent Outside the US for H-1B Extension

The below chart template will need to be completed and you will need to attach evidence of the dates you were outside the United States. Recapturing time requires evidence of the date you departed the U.S., and the date you reentered. Flight itineraries work best for this purpose, but entry and departure stamps can be used as well.

The OIS will review and make necessary changes to the chart and include it in the H-1B petition along with the evidence provided.
