MANDATORY RESEARCH SECURITY TRAINING Covered Individuals and Senior/Key Person

In accordance with <u>National Security Presidential Memorandum-33 (NSPM-33)</u> and the <u>CHIPS and Science Act</u> of 2022, Covered Individuals and Senior/Key Persons who have submitted a proposal, either directly or via a pass-through entity, or have received an award/contract from a federal/federal flow-through sponsor <u>within the previous twelve</u> (12) months, must complete the UMB Research Security Training by August 31, 2025.

A Covered Individual or Senior/Key Person is an individual who (a) contributes in a substantive, meaningful way to the scientific development or execution of a research and development project proposed to be carried out with a research and development award from a federal research agency, and (b) is designated as a Covered Individual by the federal research agency concerned. Consistent with NSPM-33, this means principal investigators (PIs) and other senior/key persons seeking or receiving federal research and development funding.

Covered Individuals and Senior/Key Persons who have submitted a proposal to a federal sponsor, either directly or through a pass-through entity, or who have received a federal award/contract (including a flow-through award/contract) within the last twelve months, have been identified in Kuali Research. These individuals will receive an email from Percipio to complete the assigned training by August 31, 2025. All other Covered Individuals and Senior/Key Persons must complete the training by September 15, 2025.

UMBs Research Security Training mirrors the National Science Foundation's training that meets federal research security requirements. The training consists of four (4) sections. Each section is 20 minutes in duration. A certificate is earned upon completion. Please download and save the certificate, which will serve as official documentation of completed training. Research Security training will be required annually.
