I. Purpose

The Purpose of this Written Directive is to guide employees of the University of Maryland, Baltimore Police Force (UMBPF) regarding their responsibilities to the Agency and to the public being served.

II. Policy

It is the policy of the UMBPF to promote a positive relationship with the public within the confines of the rules and regulations of the Agency.

III. Confidence/Respect/Accountability

A. Confidence and Respect

1. To achieve success, the UMBPF must win and retain the confidence and respect of the University of Maryland, Baltimore (UMB) and the public it serves.
2. This can be accomplished by each member having a thorough knowledge of the duties and responsibilities of their designated rank and/or position.

B. Accountability

1. All members are accountable for the execution of their duties in an efficient, honest, and competent manner.
2. It is the responsibility of each member to meet and satisfy the standards set forth in this Written Directive.
3. All members will cultivate in the public mind the realization that the UMBPF is a vital requisite to the well being of the University of Maryland, Baltimore Campus Community and to the public in general.
